## **GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT, SEXUAL HEALTH EDUCATION**

### **STATEMENT**

The California School Nurse Organization asserts that all credentialed school nurses are professionally educated in health education. Credential School Nurses understand education standards and how and where growth and development and sexual health education integrate into the Health Education Content Standards. Credential School Nurses are valuable resources and participants in the development and implementation of comprehensive growth and development and sexual health education.

#### **RATIONALE**

California school districts that provide comprehensive sexual health education, must ensure that the programs are: age appropriate; medically accurate and objective; available to English language learners; appropriate for use with pupils of all races, genders, sexual orientation, and ethnic and cultural backgrounds; appropriate for and accessible to pupils with disabilities. Comprehensive sexual health education should encourage pupil communication with their parent(s) or guardian(s) regarding human sexuality and, provide instruction regarding respect for marriage and committed relationships. Research has shown that effective family life, reproductive and human sexuality education promotes more responsible decisions such as a delay in sexual activity, rational choice between abstinence, and the use of contraceptives for sexually active adolescents.
